EB-3 CATEGORIES

Professionals

- Must be able to demonstrate that you possess a U.S. baccalaureate degree or foreign degree equivalent, and that a baccalaureate degree is the normal requirement for entry into the occupation.

Skilled Workers

- Must be able to demonstrate at least 2 years of job experience or training.
- Must be performing work for which qualified workers are not available in the United States.

Unskilled Workers

- Must be capable of performing unskilled labor (requiring less than 2 years training or experience), that is not of a temporary or seasonal nature, for which qualified workers are not available in the United States.

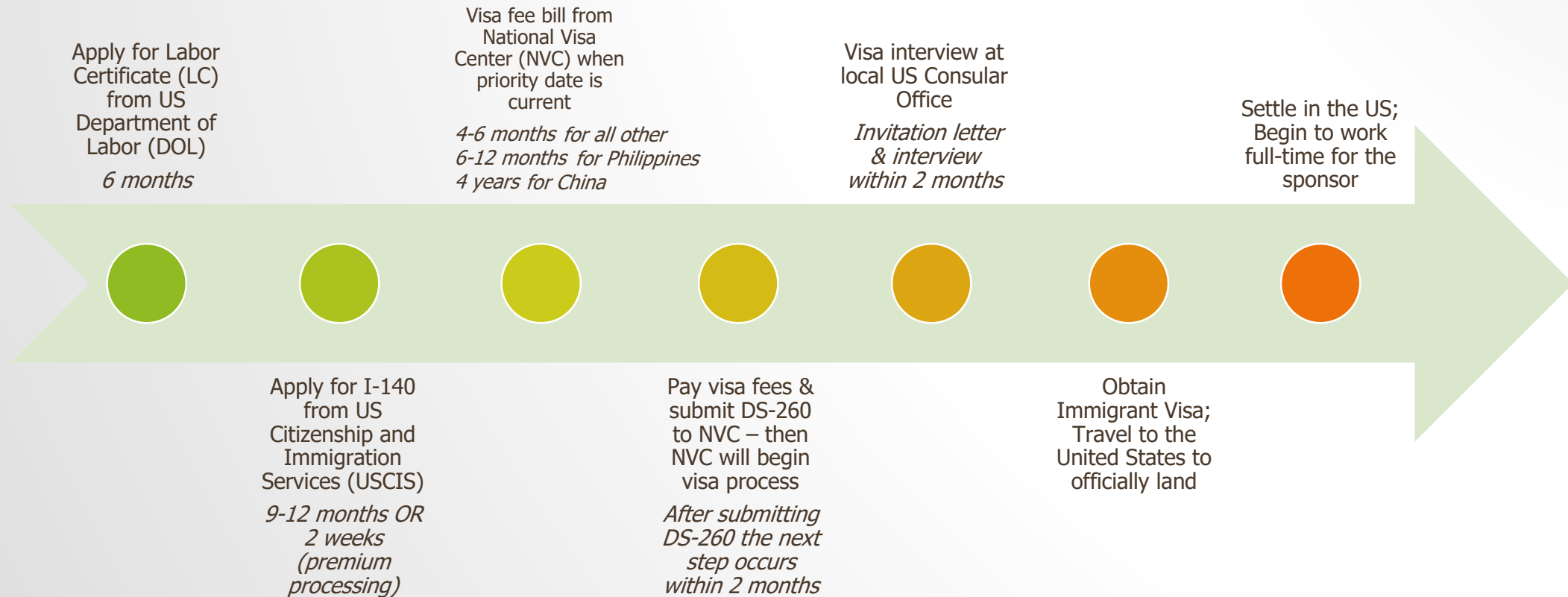
Purpose of EB-3 Other Workers (EW)

- To satisfy labor-market demand for unskilled workers in the United States, the US government offers an opportunity for eligible applicants to immigrate and work in the US under the EB-3 Immigrant Visa Program
 - Principal applicant may be accompanied by spouse and children below the age of 21. Accompanying family members are eligible to obtain a green card.

- NO assets
 - NO educational background
 - NO work experience
 - NO special language training; basic English only
 - No criminal record and good health
